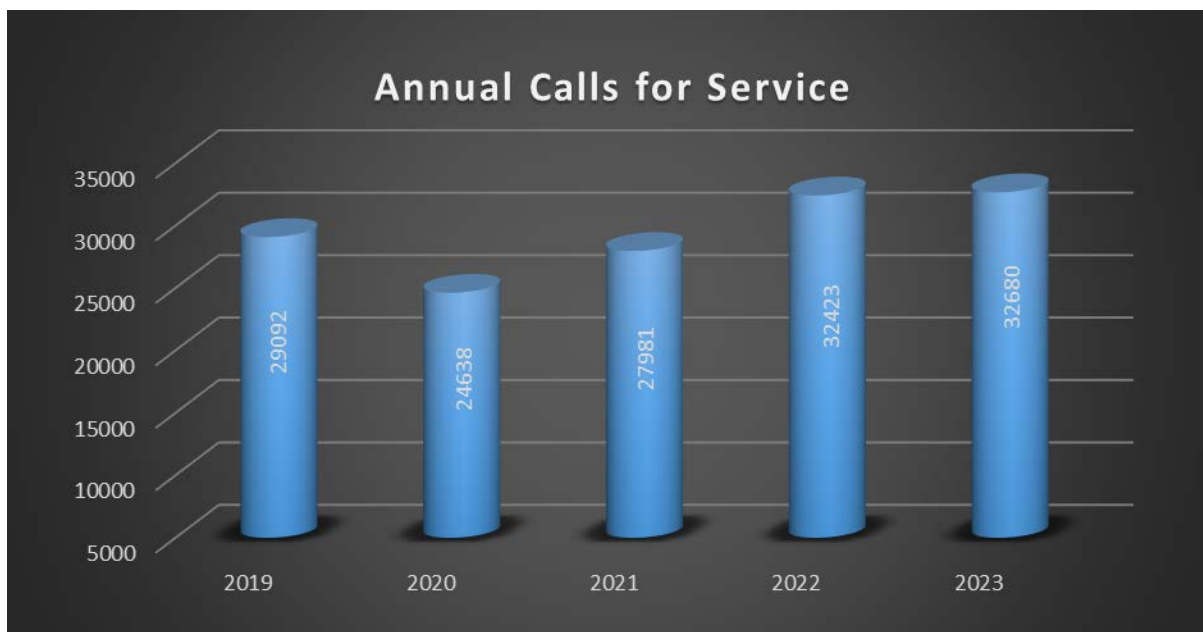

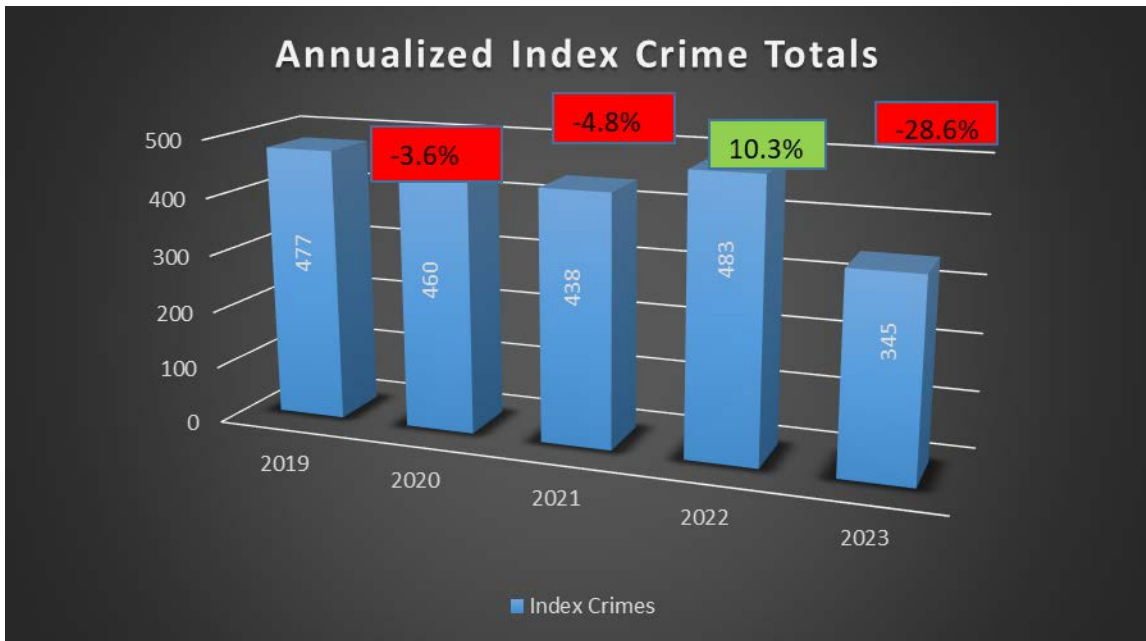
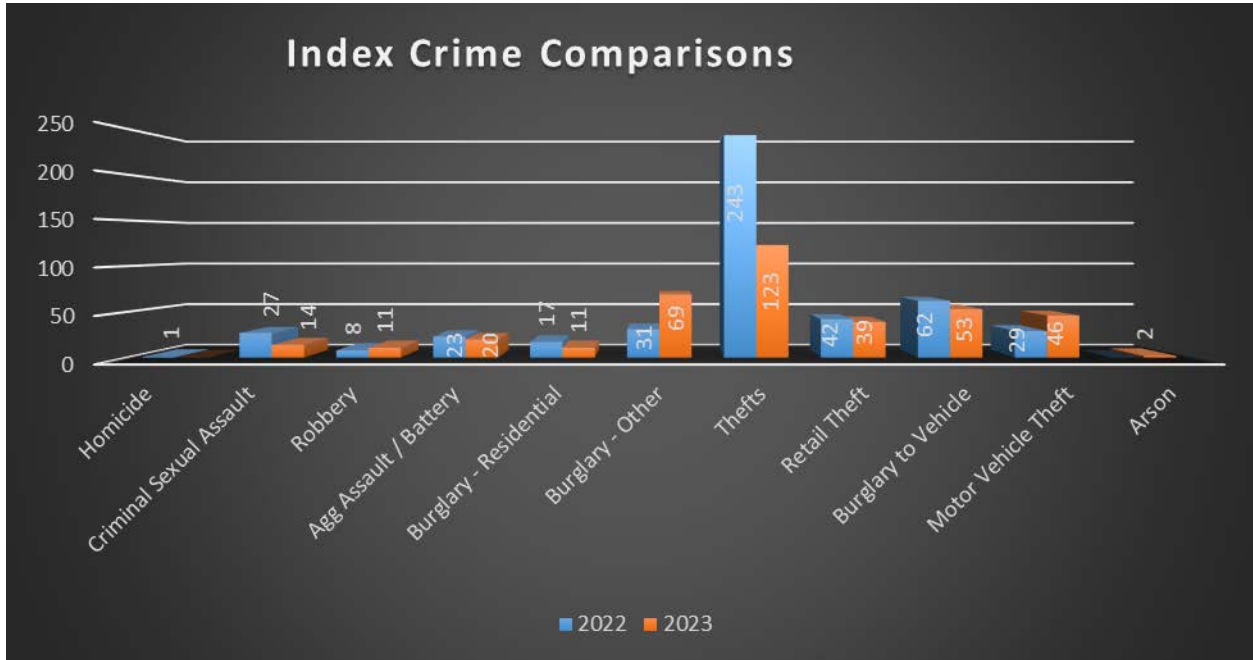
STATISTICS

Ten graphs have been included in this report to show statistics for various types of Police Department activity occurring throughout the year. Following is a brief description of each graph included in this report:

Incidents By Month – These graphs show comparisons for the last five years of all calls for service by month. The total calls for service in 2023 were 32,680. This was an increase of .8% from 2022.

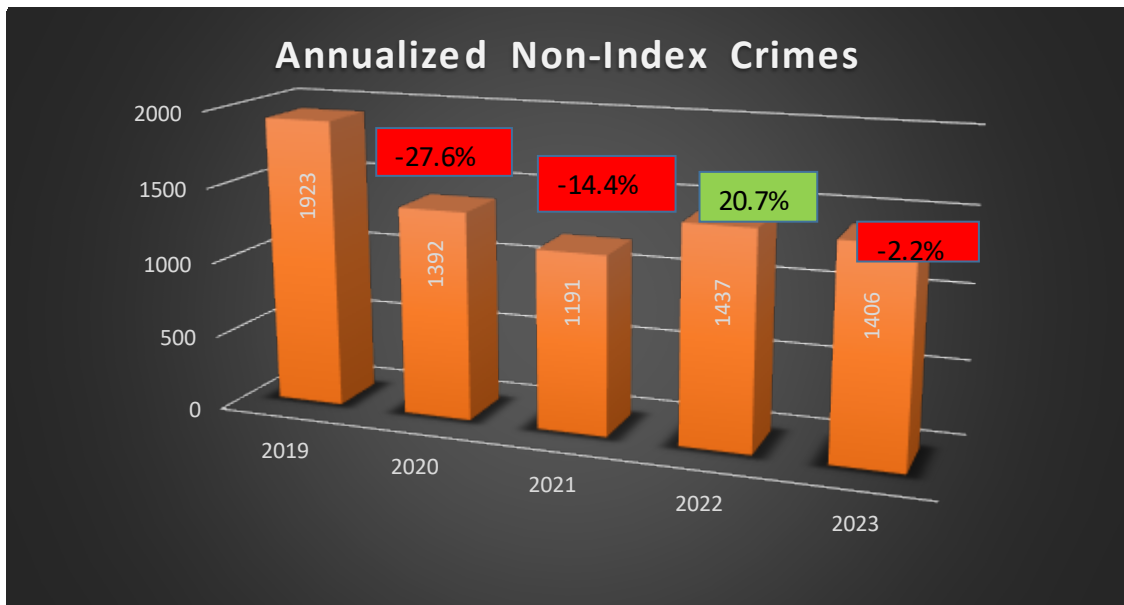
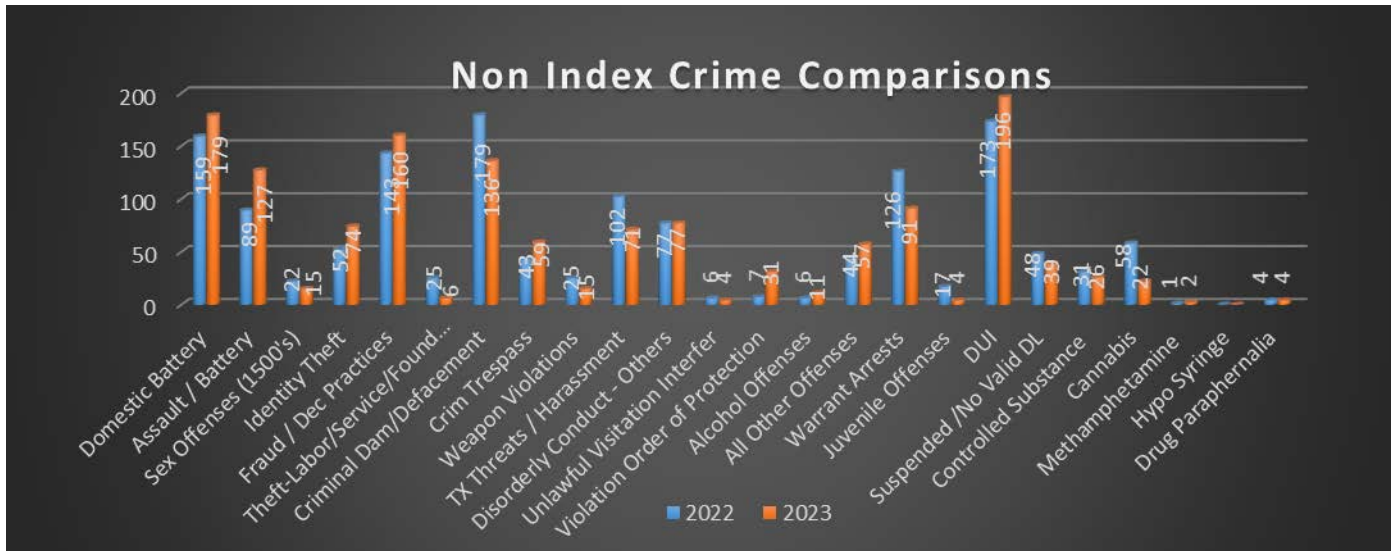


Index Crimes – There was a decrease of 8.8% in the total number of Index Crimes from 2023 from 2022. Crimes against persons decreased 28.6% in 2023 from 2022. Property crimes decreased 2.2% in 2023 from 2022.



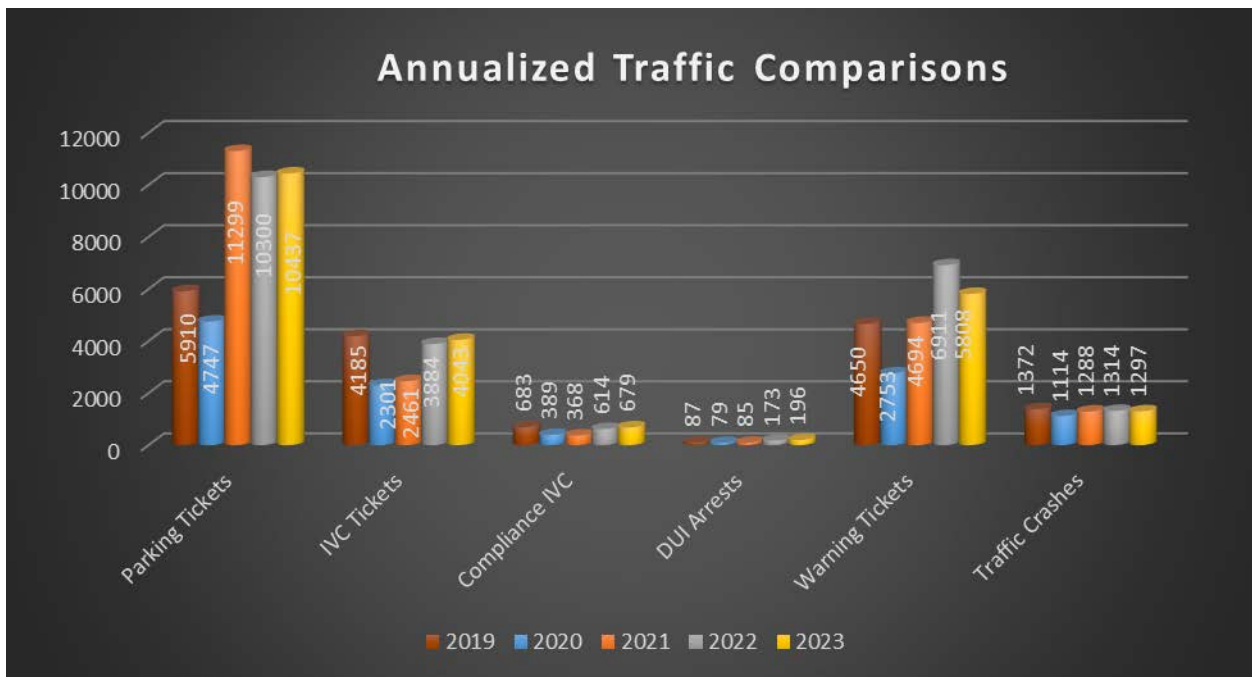
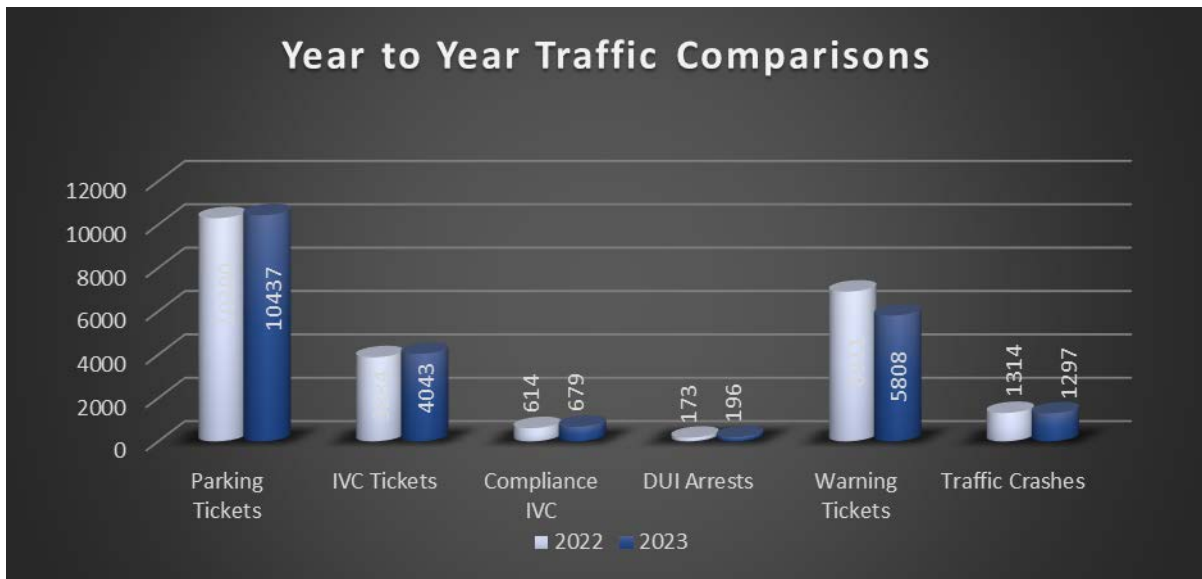
Non-Index Crimes – The total Non-Index Crimes decreased by -2.2% in 2023 from 2022. Most categories showed a decrease except for Domestic Battery, which showed an increase of 12.6%

in 2023 from 2022; Fraud/Deceptive Practices, which showed an increase of 11.9% in 2023 from 2022; and DUI arrests, which showed an increase of 13.3% in 2023 from 2022.



Annual Traffic Violations – These graphs show the productivity trends for the past five years in the categories of Traffic Tickets, Parking Tickets, DUI Arrests, Compliance Tickets and Traffic Crashes, as well as a year-to-year comparison. Parking tickets increased slightly by 1.3% in 2023 from 2022. Warning Tickets were down 15.9% in 2023 from 2022. Traffic tickets increased

4.1%, and DUI arrests increased 13.3% in 2023 from 2022. The number of Traffic Crashes decreased 1.3% in 2023 from 2022.



Yearly Crime Comparison, Yearly Arrest Comparison, and Crime and Arrest Trends –

These graphs show crime and arrest statistics for the past five years. The total number of reported crimes was down 8.8% in 2023 from 2022. Arrests for Index Crimes were down 9.1%, and arrests for Non-Index Crimes were down 3.6% in 2023 from 2022.
