Section 105.1.1, as amended by the City of Bettendorf provides a list of activities, operations, practices or functions for which it is necessary to obtain a permit from the Bettendorf Fire, Rescue & Emergency Services Department.

Section 10-7-3 of the City of Bettendorf Municipal Code and section 105.1.1 of the International Fire Code require a fee to be paid for each permit that is required. Each individual activity requires a separate permit.

FIRE DEPARTMENT REQUIRED PERMITS

Permit requirements are listed in Sections 105 through 105.7.14 of the 2021 International Fire Code. Some of these sections are included below.

International Fire Code (as amended and adopted by the City of Bettendorf)

105.1.1 Permits Required: Permits required by this code shall be obtained from the chief or his/her designee. The permit fee based on the value of the job shall be paid prior to issuance of the permit. The permit fee for a city department shall be waived, however, a permit is still required. Issued permits shall be kept on the premises designated therein at all times and shall be readily available for inspection by the fire chief or his/her designee. Permits shall be obtained prior to engaging in the following activities as noted in the respective code section:

105.6.2 Amusement buildings.

105.6.30 Open burning.

105.6.36 Pyrotechnical special effects material

105.7 Required construction permits. The following permits are required and shall be issued by the Bettendorf Building Inspection Services Department as set forth in the sections noted below. Permit fees for construction permits shall be as established under the International Building Code (Chapter 7, Section 7-11 of the City Code).

105.7.1 Automatic fire-extinguishing systems 105.7.3

Compressed gases.

105.7.5 Fire alarm and detection systems and related equipment.

105.7.6 Fire pumps and related equipment.

105.7.7 Flammable and combustible liquids.

105.7.8 Hazardous materials.

105.7.12 Spraying or dipping.

105.7.13 Standpipe systems.

105.7.14 Temporary membrane structures, tents and canopies.
