ORDINANCE # 2026-14

THE ORDINANCE BELOW WAS INTRODUCED AND PASSED FOR ITS FIRST READING ON MAY 4, 2026. IT HAS BEEN PRESENTED FOR A SECOND READING, PUBLIC HEARING & ADOPTION AT 7:00 P.M. IN THE DUNELLEN BOROUGH MUNICIPAL BUILDING, 355 NORTH AVENUE, DUNELLEN, NEW JERSEY, ON MAY 18, 2026 AND COPIES OF THIS ORDINANCE HAVE BEEN POSTED ON THE PUBLIC BULLETIN BOARD PRIOR TO THE DATE FOR SECOND READING AND FINAL PASSAGE AND COPIES OF THIS ORDINANCE HAVE BEEN AVAILABLE AT THE OFFICE OF THE BOROUGH CLERK, 355 NORTH AVENUE, FOR ANY INTERESTED MEMBERS OF THE PUBLIC.

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND AND SUPPLEMENT THE GENERAL LEGISLATION OF THE BOROUGH OF DUNELLEN CHAPTER 202, SECTION 18 (C)

BE IT ORDAINED by the Borough Council of the Borough of Dunellen, Middlesex County, State of New Jersey, as follows:

1. Section 202-18 (C), entitled Handicapped Parking- On Street Restricted Parking Zones, shall be and is hereby amended and supplemented by adding the following:

C. On Street Restricted Parking Zones are established pursuant to N.J.S.A. 39:4-197.6 as defined in N.J.S.A. 39:4-207e meaning a parking zone in front of a residence of a person with a disability which the Borough has established for the use of that person.

Restricted Parking Zones

1. 372 Whittier Avenue
2. 240 Prospect Avenue
3. 701 Dunellen Avenue on Sanford Avenue
4. 516 First Street
5. 435 Front Street
6. **825 Second Street**

2. **SEVERABILITY.** If any paragraph, section, subsection, sentence, sentence clause, phrase, or portion of this ordinance is for any reason held invalid or unconstitutional by any Court or administrative agency of competent jurisdiction, such portion shall be deemed a separate, distinct, and independent provision of such holding shall not affect the validity of the remaining paragraphs or sections hereof.

3. **INCONSISTENCY.** All ordinances or parts of ordinances inconsistent with this ordinance are hereby repealed to the extent of such inconsistency.

4. **EFFECTIVE DATE.** This ordinance shall take effect upon final passage and publication according to law.
