

**BREMER COUNTY  
RESOLUTION NO. 24-69**

**WHEREAS, Section 321.345 of the Code of Iowa authorizes the Board of Supervisors to designate through highways and designate any intersection or specified entrance as a stop intersection, and**

**WHEREAS, In the interest of the safety of the traveling public, the Bremer County Engineer recommends that the northbound and southbound lanes at the intersection of Oakland Avenue and 110<sup>th</sup> Street are deemed to warrant a stop sign.**

**NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Bremer County Board of Supervisors that in Sec. 9 T-93N/R-12W all traffic entering 110<sup>th</sup> Street from Oakland Avenue from the south shall stop, and that in Sec. 5 T-93N/R-12W all traffic entering 110<sup>th</sup> Street from Oakland Avenue from the north shall stop, and**

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Bremer County Highway Department shall erect the appropriate signs in accordance with the Manual On Uniform Traffic Control Devices For Streets And Highways.**
