



NO PARKING ORDINANCE

Bremer County Ordinance No. 25-06

AN ORDINANCE SETTING PROCEDURES FOR ESTABLISHMENT AND ENFORCEMENT PENALTIES FOR NO PARKING ZONES IN BREMER COUNTY, IOWA.

BE IT ENACTED by the Board of Supervisors of Bremer County, Iowa:

SECTION I - Purpose. The purpose of this Ordinance is to establish certain portions of this county's roads as no parking areas, as authorized by sections 321.239, 321.236, and 321.255 Code of Iowa, in order to regulate the standing or parking of vehicles on streets and highways under its jurisdiction and to place and maintain appropriate traffic control devices.

SECTION II - Permanent and seasonal no parking zone locations.


Upon the recommendation of the county engineer, the county board of supervisors may designate, by resolution, certain locations as no parking zones. All such no parking zones shall be posted with signs so indicating. The resolution establishing these no parking zones shall state whether this designation is permanent (full time) or seasonal (temporary).

SECTION III - Penalties.

Vehicles found to be in violation of Section II shall be subject to citation, with a fine of \$25.00, and may be towed immediately. The towing of any vehicles pursuant to this article shall be at the owner's expense.

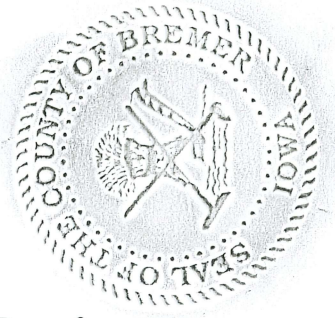
