

RESOLUTION FOR REDUCED LEVEL OF MAINTENANCE TO AREA SERVICE “B” ROAD

Bremer County Resolution No. 25-69

WHEREAS, Bremer County desires to classify certain roads on the area service system in the County to provide for a minimal level of maintenance; and

WHEREAS, Bremer County, after consultation with the County Engineer, has the authority to specify certain roads within the County as Area Service “B” roads pursuant to Iowa Code Section 309.57; and

WHEREAS, the Bremer County Board of Supervisors, after consulting with the Bremer County Engineer, desire to designate various roads in Bremer County on the Area Service “B” System to provide for a reduced level of maintenance in order to best utilize maintenance funds, and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Notice of Public Hearing duly published according to the Iowa Code, Public Hearing as held on the 24 day of June, 2025 at 10:00 a.m. in the Board of Supervisors room at the Bremer County Courthouse, Waverly, Iowa, to hear support and/or objections from the public on roads so designated.

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF BREMER COUNTY that this County does hereby establish the road described as an Area Service “B” road, with restricted access and a minimal level of maintenance.

In Section 26, Township 91N, Range 14W: Unnamed County Road, from the intersection of North Maple Street East approximately 700 feet to the end of the road.

In Section 32, Township 92N, Range 11W: Teal Avenue, from the intersection of 215th Street South and East approximately 4940 feet to the intersection of the residential drive at 2992 220th Street.

In Sections 8 and 9, Township 92N, Range 14W: 170th Street, from the intersection of Bishop Avenue East approximately 4870 feet to the end of the road.
