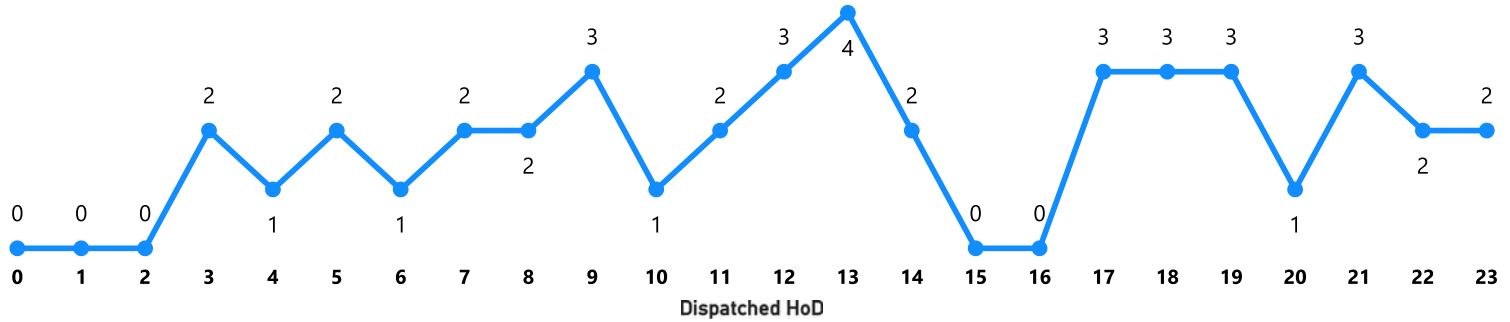

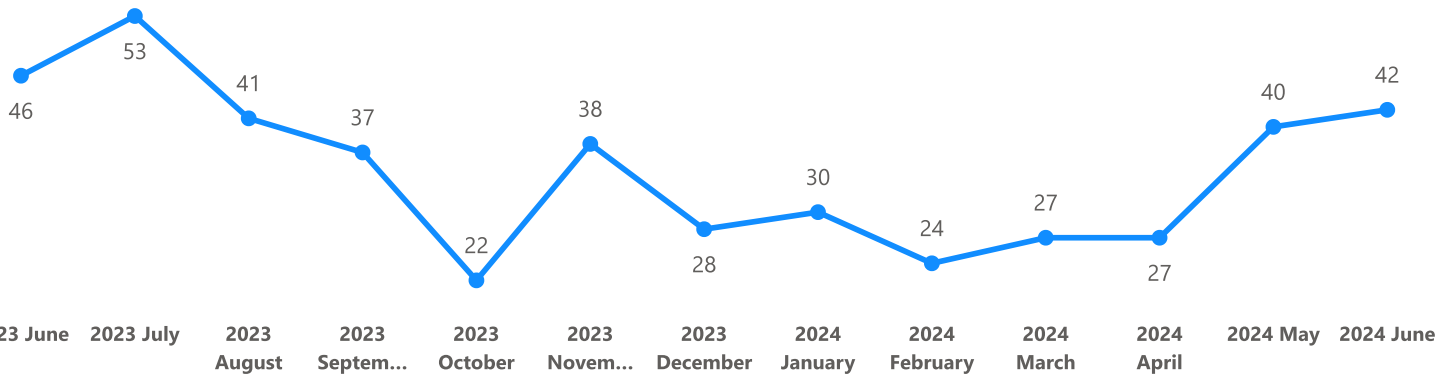

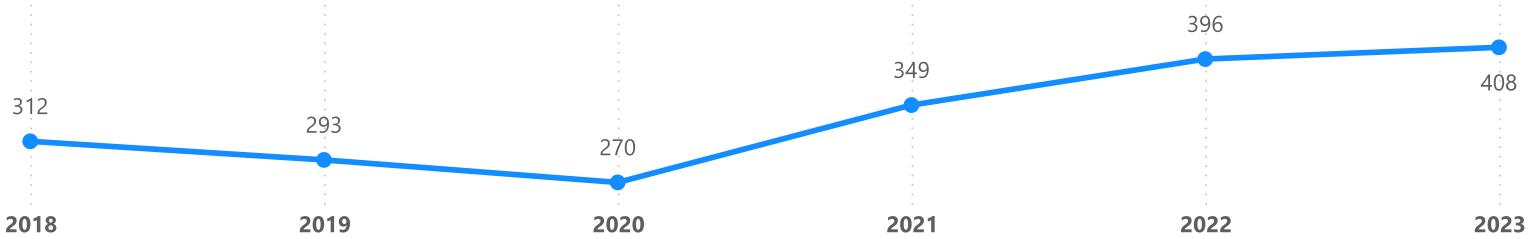
Total Number Incidents by Hour of Day for Report Month

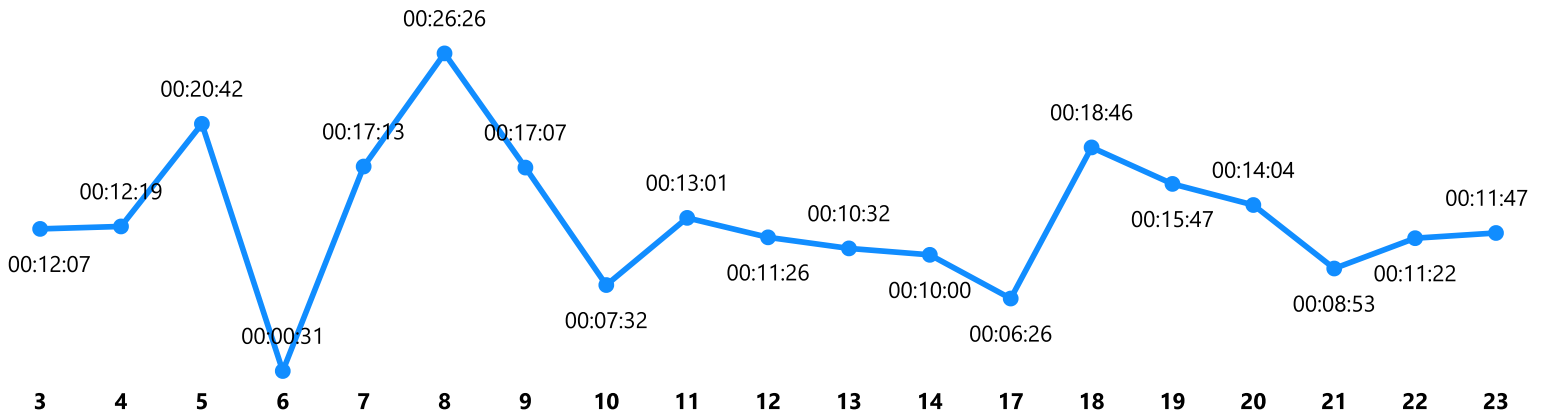

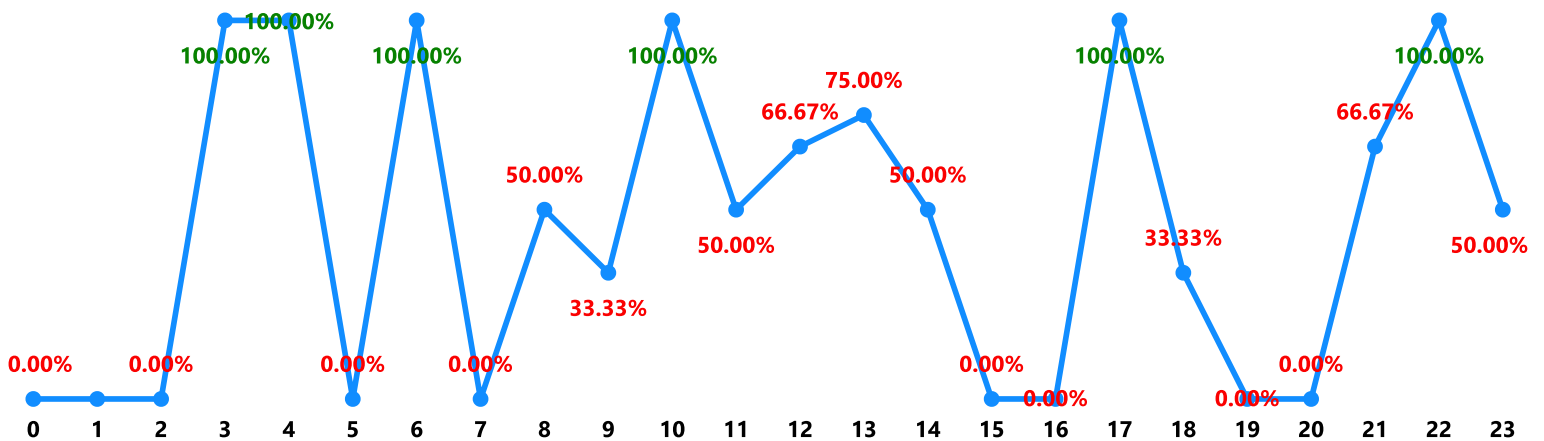

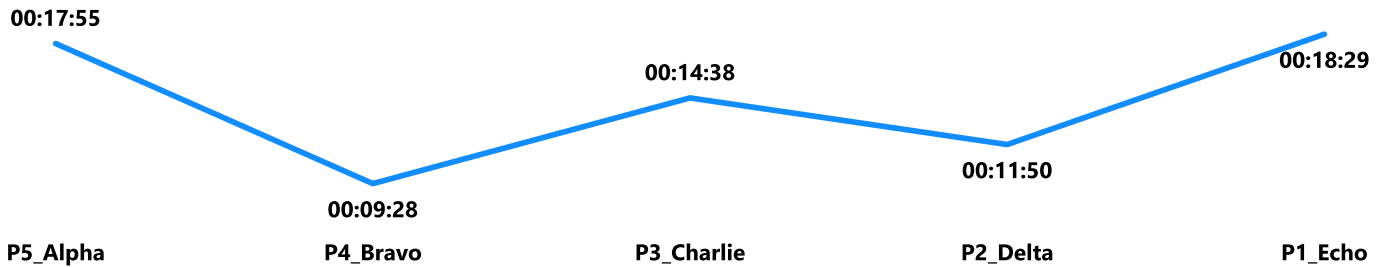

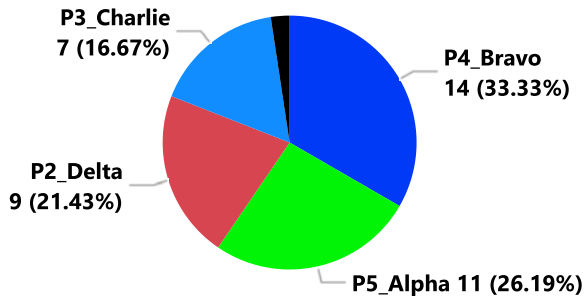

## Average of Response Time by Dispatch Priority

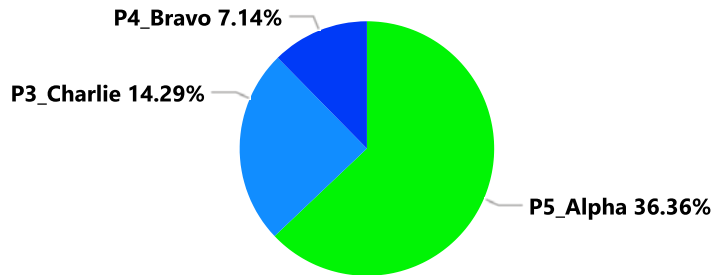
