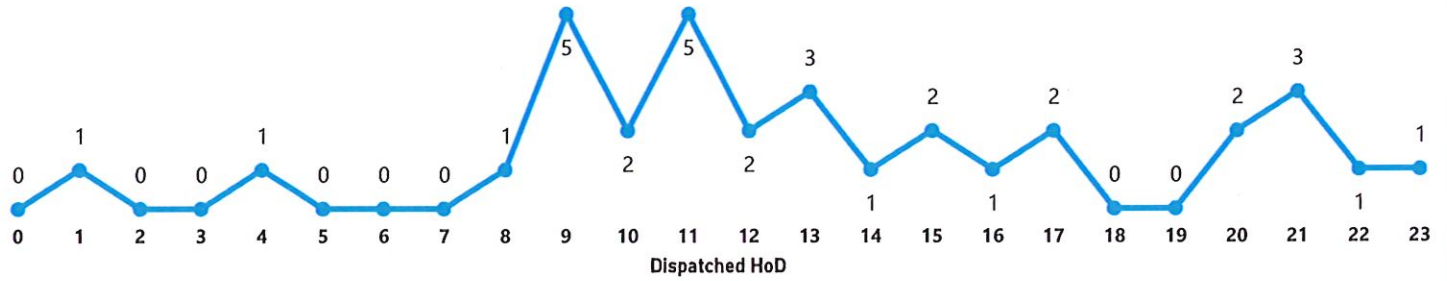

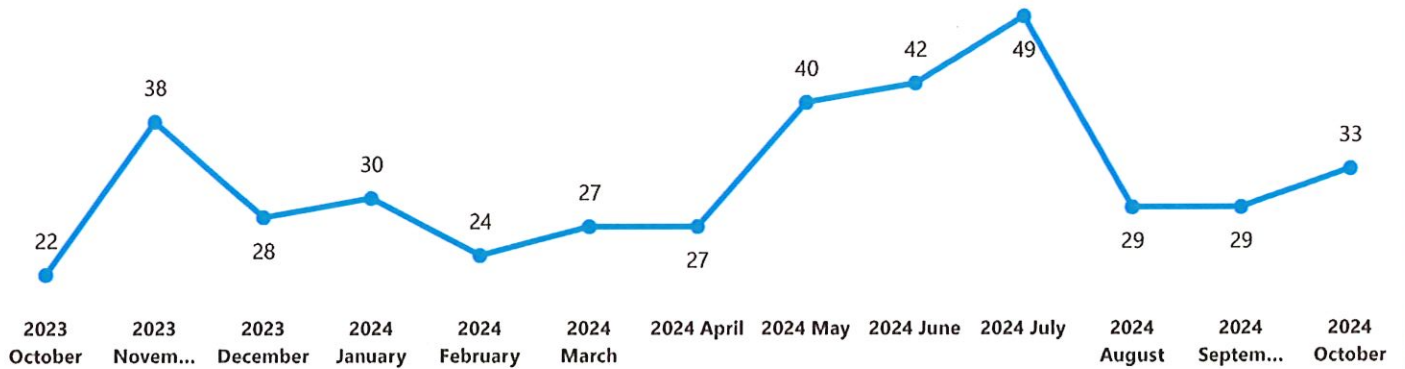

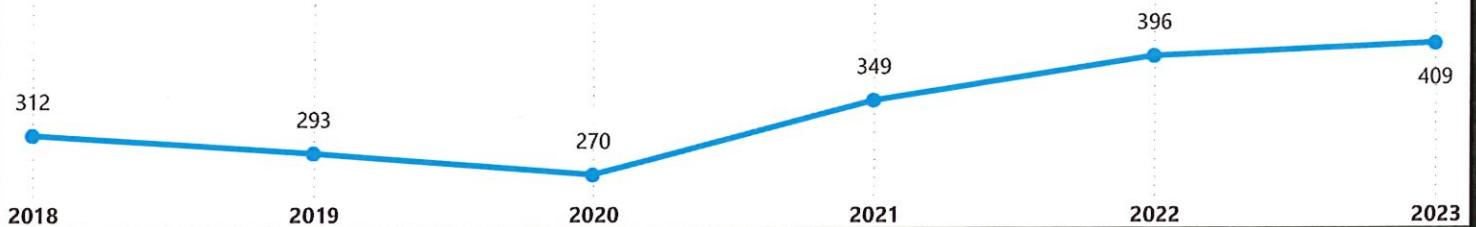
Total Number Incident Arrivals by Hour of Day for Report Month

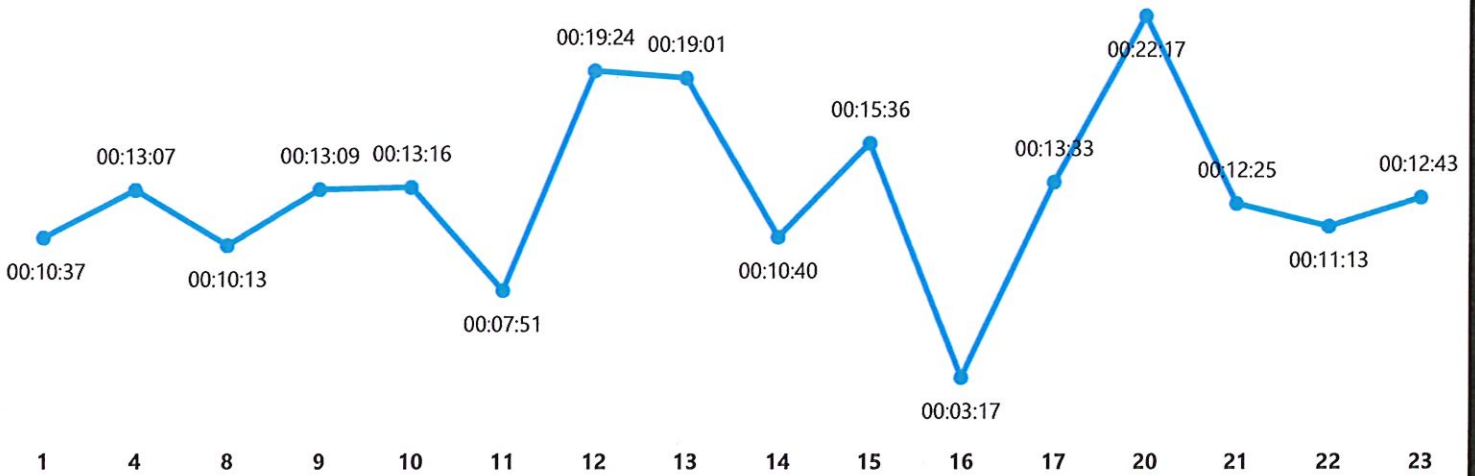

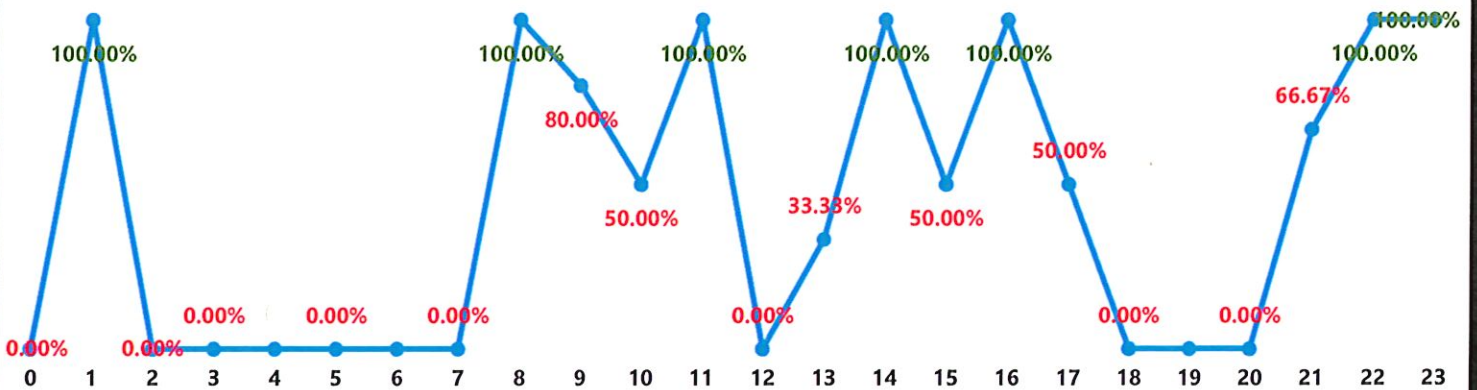

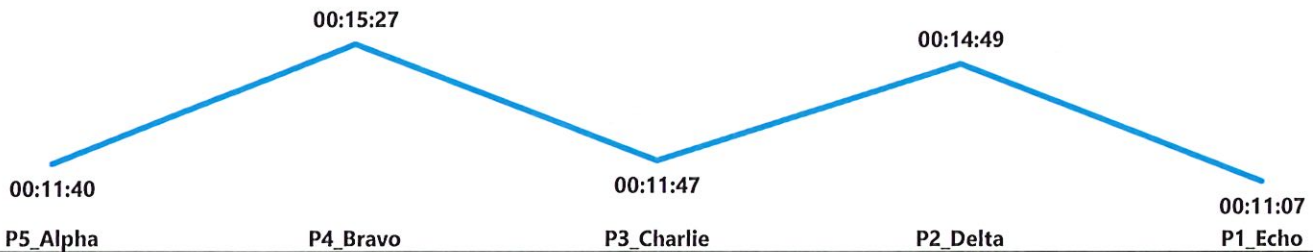

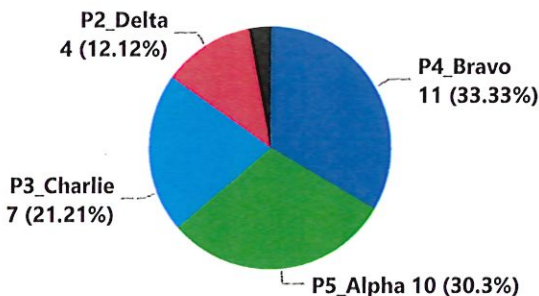

HH:MM:SS

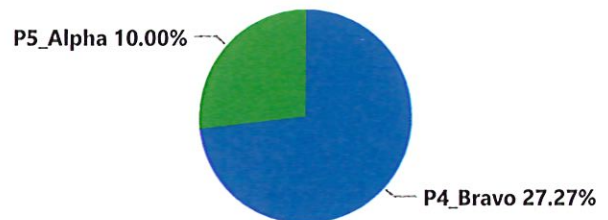


of Incident Arrivals by DispatchPriority
