



LA MIRADA REMAINS AMONG REGION'S SAFEST CITIES

The City continues to demonstrate its commitment to safety by maintaining one of the lowest crime rates in the region. The City's low crime rate is attributed to a strong partnership between the Public Safety Team and the community.

In 2024, there were 875 Part 1 crimes reported in La Mirada compared to 981 reported in 2023. The number of Part 1 crimes reported in other cities patrolled by the Los Angeles County Sheriff's Department include Paramount 1,696; Bellflower 2,054; Norwalk 2,261; Cerritos 2,273; and Lakewood 2,325. The majority of Part 1 crimes in 2024 were property crimes. Of the 875 Part 1 crimes reported in La Mirada, 832 were property crimes. This accounts for 95 percent of Part 1 crimes reported in 2024. Crimes against persons decreased from 59 incidents in 2023 to 43 in 2024.

The Public Safety Team engaged in a variety of outreach efforts to educate the community on crime trends and prevention techniques. Neighborhood Watch meetings were held throughout La Mirada to discuss residents' concerns and share information. The Public Safety Team also partnered with the La Mirada Chamber of Commerce to host a National Coffee with a Cop event in October to strengthen the partnership with deputies and the community. Additionally, the Public Safety Team coordinated several community events, including National Night Out in August.

The Public Safety Team will continue to prioritize high-visibility enforcement to deter criminal activity in commercial and residential areas. Deputies and Public Safety Officers will maintain a consistent presence as a proactive measure to prevent property crimes.

SBA ECONOMIC INJURY DISASTER LOANS AVAILABLE FOR LOCAL BUSINESSES

The U.S. Small Business Administration (SBA) is offering Economic Injury Disaster Loans (EIDLs) to support small businesses, agricultural cooperatives, and nonprofit organizations in La Mirada and surrounding areas that have been economically impacted by the recent California wildfires. These federal loans are designed to help eligible businesses cover essential operating expenses that they are unable to meet due to disaster-related revenue losses.

Businesses may qualify for up to \$2 million in assistance to help pay normal expenses including fixed debts, rent, utilities, and health care benefits. The loans offer favorable terms with interest rates not exceeding 4% and repayment periods of up to 30 years. Payments are deferred for 12 months from the date of the first disbursement, providing businesses with critical time as they continue to recover.

To be eligible, businesses must be located in a declared disaster area, such as Los Angeles County, and demonstrate substantial economic injury as a result of the wildfires. Applications can be completed online through the SBA's website.
