8. **TRAFFIC STUDY OF HEIGHTS CHRISTIAN JUNIOR HIGH SCHOOL** - It is recommended the Public Safety and Traffic Commission approve the installation of five additional feet of red curb near the exit on Bluefield Avenue to increase the sight distance for vehicles when they exit the parking loop.
9. **TRAFFIC STUDY OF HUTCHINSON MIDDLE SCHOOL** - It is recommended the Public Safety and Traffic Commission approve the recommendation for the City to encourage the Norwalk-La Mirada Unified School District to install a “Right Turn Only 7:30 a.m. to 9:30 a.m. and 1:30 p.m. to 3:30 p.m.” sign at the exit of the front parking lot loop.
10. **TRAFFIC STUDY OF ST. PAUL OF THE CROSS CATHOLIC SCHOOL** - It is recommended the Public Safety and Traffic Commission approve the recommendation for the City to encourage the school administration to consider the installation of a double sided “Entrance Only” signage or “One Way” signage at the entrance of the parking lot; approve the completion of a safety analysis at the intersection of Parise Drive and Foster Road; and assign the Traffic Engineer and a Commissioner to study the location and report their findings at a future meeting.
