2026 Independence Celebration FAQs
INDEPENDENCE CELEBRATION

Friday, July 3 from 4-9p
La Mirada Regional Park, 13701 Adelfa Drive
Live Music • Food Vendors • Fireworks • Patriotic Program

1. **Q:** What time is the event?

A: The event will be from 4 - 9 p.m.

2. **Q:** Where is the event located?

A: 13701 Adelfa Drive, La Mirada Regional Park. Food vendors and musical performances will be set up on the east side of Regional Park.

3. **Q:** How early can I reserve an area?

A: Patrons can begin setting up their items as early as 6 a.m. on Friday, July 3. No overnight set up is permitted. Personal property left on the park earlier than 6 a.m. on July 3 may be removed by park staff. City of La Mirada and County of Los Angeles staff are not responsible for personal property left unattended on the park site.

4. **Q:** Where is the event parking?

A: Parking will be available at La Mirada Regional Park. Overflow parking will be available at La Mirada Civic Center, the stadium parking lot at La Mirada High School and Biola University (entrance off La Mirada Boulevard). The City will provide free shuttle service from Biola University beginning at 3 p.m. Shuttle service will stop approximately 45 minutes after the event.

5. **Q:** Are RVs allowed?

A: Vehicles no longer than 20 feet may park in lots. All vehicles must fit within the marked lines of the parking stall. Vehicle parking will also be permitted in select areas as marked on the north and south sides of Foster Road between Santa Gertrudes Avenue and Lisburn Place on July 3 from 10 a.m. to 11 p.m. All vehicles parked on Foster Road before 10 a.m. on July 3 may be subject to a citation.
Recreational vehicles (RVs) are not be permitted to park on Foster Road.

Overnight parking will not be permitted at La Mirada Regional Park.
Vehicles may be cited or towed.

6. **Q:** What is the entertainment for the night?

A: There will be two performances.

- 4-6 p.m. Stone Soul (Motown)
- 6:30-8:30 p.m. The Purple Generation (Prince Tribute)

7. **Q:** When is the Patriotic Program (fireworks show)?

A: Fireworks begin approximately at 9 p.m.

8. Q: What type of food is offered?

A: Typical items available for purchase are Kettle Corn, Shaved Ice, Tacos, Agua Frescas, Funnel Cake, Root Beer Floats, Nachos, Hot Dogs, Hamburgers, Fried Foods, and Soft Drinks. Food choices are subject to change.

9. Q: What is the cost of food, and do you take cash?

A: Food costs vary between \$5-\$25. Forms of payment vary between vendors. Please be prepared with both cash and debit card.

10. Q: Can guests grill at La Mirada Regional Park?

A: Only propane-operated grills are permitted at La Mirada Regional Park. Alcoholic beverages are strictly prohibited.

11. Q: Are alcoholic beverages served/allowed at the event?

A: Alcoholic beverages are strictly prohibited at the event site. Those consuming alcoholic beverages at the event site may be subject to a citation and up to being removed from the event site.

12. Q: Where do vendors park?

A: Vendor parking will be available onsite in parking lots at the park entrance off Adelfa. All vendors will receive instructions on where they are permitted to park and will be provided with parking passes that accommodate their vehicles.
