**ORDINANCE FIXING THE TAX LEVY IN THE URBAN SERVICES FUND OF
THE HARTSVILLE/TROUSDALE COUNTY GOVERNMENT
FOR THE FISCAL YEAR BEGINNING JULY 1, 2022**

SECTION 1. BE IT ORDAINED by the Urban Services Council of the Hartsville/Trousdale County Government assembled in regular session, that the combined property tax rate for the Urban Services Fund(s) of the Hartsville/Trousdale County Government for the fiscal year beginning **July 1, 2022 shall be \$0.6731 on each \$100.00 of taxable property**, which is to provide revenue for each of the following funds and otherwise conform to the following levies:

Fund	Rate
Urban Services	\$ 0.6731
Total	\$ 0.6731

SECTION 2. BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED that all ordinances of the Urban Services Council of the Hartsville/Trousdale County Government which are in conflict with this ordinance are hereby repealed.

SECTION 3. BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED that this ordinance take effect from and after its passage, the public welfare requiring it. This ordinance shall be spread upon the minutes of the Board of County Commissioners.


