**RESOLUTION NAMING THE HIGH SCHOOL REPRESENTATIVE OF THE COUNTY COMMISSION
FOR THE 2019-2020 SCHOOL YEAR**

WHEREAS, the Hartsville/Trousdale Metropolitan County is governed by a Legislative Body made up of two Commissioners from each District, in total twenty members; and

WHEREAS, it is important to continually develop and train new County leaders and therefore fitting to select a High School student who can learn how the local County Metropolitan Government operates by attending and actively participating in Commission meetings, work sessions, and committee meetings.

WHEREAS, it has been resolved by the Hartsville/Trousdale County Commission that on an annual basis for a term beginning September 1 and ending July 31 of each year, one High School Student shall be selected to become a Student Representative of the County Commission. The Student Representative shall be allowed the privilege of attending all meetings and functions of the County Commission, permitted to enter all discussions and debates, and permitted to vote on all matters. However, the Student Representative's vote shall not be included in the official vote tally.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, for the Commission year beginning September 1, 2019 through July 31, 2020, this Commission names **Cameron Carr** to be the High School Representative for the County Commission.
