**A RESOLUTION TO SUPPORT TRI-COUNTY ELECTRIC MEMBERSHIP CORPORATION'S
TENNESSEE BROADBAND ACCESSIBILITY GRANT APPLICATION**

WHEREAS, Governor Haslam's Broadband legislation (Public Chapter 228) enables Tri-County Electric Membership Corporation and other electric cooperatives to provide broadband in their service areas, except areas where a rural telephone cooperative is the incumbent local exchange carrier (ILEC), and

WHEREAS, Tri-County Electric Membership Corporation has completed of Phase 1 of their broadband fiber network in Trousdale County and has been diligently working on Phase 2; and

WHEREAS, Hartsville/Trousdale County Government has been working with Tri-County Electric since 2014 to provide broadband to residents;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Hartsville/Trousdale County Commission supports the 2019 Tennessee Broadband Grant application submitted by Tri-County Fiber Communications (TCFC), a wholly owned subsidiary of Tri-County Electric and looks forward to continue our partnership with the electric cooperative to provide broadband service to the residents of Hartsville/Trousdale County.
