**RESOLUTION TO EXTEND THE ALLOTTED VACATION TIME
FOR JAIL SECURITY GUARD EMPLOYEES OF THE SHERIFF DEPARTMENT DUE TO COVID-19**

WHEREAS, one of the objectives of the Hartsville/Trousdale County Metropolitan Government Personnel Policies as stated in the Section 1.B.3 is "to establish and promote high morale among the employees by providing good working relationships, a uniform personnel policy, opportunity for advancement, and consideration of employee needs and desires."; and

WHEREAS, our Nation and our County have been greatly affected by the Covid-19 virus as it effects the health of our families, friends, coworkers, and first responders including law enforcement, emergency services and health care providers; and

WHEREAS, as a result of COVID-19, many of Hartsville/Trousdale County Metropolitan Government employees and personnel vacation benefits will not carry over after December 31, 2020. It is the desire of the County Commission in response to the COVID-19 pandemic to extend and/or carryover the allotted vacation benefit for the Jail Guard employees of the Hartsville/Trousdale County Sheriff Department.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Hartsville/Trousdale County Commission that in response to the COVID-19 pandemic the 2020 unused vacation benefit for Jail Guard employees are hereby carried over and/or extended into the 2021 year and expire on April 30, 2021.

It is the intent of the County Commission this RESOLUTION shall apply retroactively if necessary.


