RESOLUTION #2021-17-721

**A RESOLUTION TO DIRECT THE RELOCATION OF THE ELECTION COMMISSION OFFICES
TO THE TROUSDALE COUNTY COURTHOUSE**

WHEREAS, Tennessee Code Annotated § 5-5-121 authorizes and empowers county legislative bodies to control county buildings within the limitations as provided by law; and

WHEREAS, in 1988 the UT Agriculture Extension Agency and the Trousdale Election Commission were moved into the vacant Board of Education building located at 214 Broadway; and

WHEREAS, upon a positive recommendation from the Buildings Committee, and consideration of alternate options, the Hartsville/Trousdale County Commission finds there is a need for expansion of space for the UT Agriculture Extension Agency office located at 214 Broadway due to new employee requirements mandated by the State of Tennessee; and

WHEREAS, upon further consideration, the Hartsville/Trousdale County Commission finds there is adequate space available in the Historic Trousdale County Courthouse located at 200 E Main Street that would accommodate the needs of the Trousdale County Election Commission.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Hartsville/Trousdale County Commission, meeting in regular session that the Trousdale County Election Commission shall relocate from their current offices at 214 Broadway to the Trousdale County Courthouse located at 200 E Main Street in a space provided by the Hartsville/Trousdale County Government by not later than February 1, 2022.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Hartsville/Trousdale County Commission authorizes the County Attorney to use all legal means necessary to ensure this move is completed not later than February 1, 2022.
