

HARTSVILLE/TROUSDALE COUNTY GOVERNMENT  
**RESOLUTION #2021-23-727**

**A RESOLUTION SUPPORTING AND APPROVING THE SUBMISSION OF A  
MULTI-MODAL ACCESS GRANT PROGRAM APPLICATION  
TO THE TENNESSEE DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION.**

**WHEREAS**, the Tennessee Department of Transportation has responsibility for the administration of the Tennessee Department of Transportation Multi-Modal Access Grant program (MMAG), which is designed to assist communities in their efforts to enhance transportation access and quality of life along and within close proximity to state routes; and

**WHEREAS**, Hartsville/Trousdale County Government, acting by and through the Hartsville/Trousdale County Commission, proposes to apply for 2021-2022 MMAG funds for the purpose of performing eligible transportation enhancement activities to benefit the residents of Hartsville and Trousdale County; and

**WHEREAS**, Hartsville/Trousdale County Government will provide local financial support in conjunction with the MMAG funds to complete the project.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND HARTSVILLE/TROUSDALE COUNTY COMMISSION**, as follows:

**SECTION 1.** Mayor Stephen Chambers is hereby authorized to submit an intent to apply, and to execute and submit an application with appropriate assurances to the State of Tennessee, Department of Transportation, requesting Fiscal Year 2022 MMAG funds for re-constructing existing sidewalks and the construction of new sidewalks from the intersection of Broadway (State Route 141) and White Oak Street, north to the intersection of SR 141 and SR 25 in Hartsville.

**SECTION 2.** Hartsville/Trousdale County Government will be responsible for the 5% local cash match, not to exceed \$50,000, toward the project to be provided in full by the Urban Services fund and will be responsible for the future maintenance of the improvements.

**SECTION 3.** The County Mayor is hereby directed to file in his office a duplicate or copy of the agreement after it has been executed by the parties or their duly authorized representatives.

**SECTION 4.** This Resolution takes effect immediately upon its passage and approval, the public welfare requiring it.
