**A RESOLUTION TO AUTHORIZE APPLICATION TO AND EXECUTION OF FUNDING FROM
THE STATE OF TENNESSEE**

**DEPARTMENT OF ECONOMIC AND COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT OFFICE
FOR THE 2022 COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT BLOCK GRANT PROGRAM**

WHEREAS, the Tennessee Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) Program has been established to assist local governments in meeting community development and housing needs consistent with the objectives as set forth in Title 1 of the Housing and Community Development Act of 1974, as amended; and

WHEREAS, the Hartsville/Trousdale County Metropolitan Government acting by and through its Mayor and County Commission proposes to apply for Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) funds for the purpose of performing eligible community development activities that will benefit residents in Hartsville/Trousdale County; and

WHEREAS, there exist areas within Hartsville/Trousdale County comprised of primarily low to moderate income individuals in need of improvements to the housing stock; and

WHEREAS, the Hartsville/Trousdale County Metropolitan Government desires to pursue CDBG funds to address the needs of the low-income home owners residing within the designated areas.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Hartsville/Trousdale County Commission as follows:

1. The Mayor be authorized and directed to execute and submit an application with appropriate assurances to the State of Tennessee, Department of Economic and Community Development, Office of Community and Rural Development, requesting Fiscal Year 2022 Community Development Block Grant funds in an amount not to exceed \$525,000, plus any eligible Three-Star bonus allowance, for the above mentioned project; and to enter into all necessary agreements to receive and administer such grant funds.
2. Matching funds are not applicable to CDBG Housing Rehabilitation projects.
