**A RESOLUTION TO ADD PRIVATE DRIVES TO THE OFFICIAL ROAD NAME LIST
FOR EMERGENCY SERVICES IDENTIFICATION**

WHEREAS, the Trousdale County Emergency Communications Board has the responsibility of assigning road names to county roads and private drives to better serve the public in emergency situations; and

WHEREAS, at its last quarterly meeting on January 14, 2025, the Board approved the naming or renaming of the below private drive.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Hartsville/Trousdale County Commission meeting in regular session that the following private drive is named for the purpose of providing an accurate address location in the event of an emergency and in no way indicates that this is a county-maintained road:

COMPOUND LANE

– located west of Lebanon Pike, 0.855 north of the Wilson County line

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that approval of this resolution shall in no way affect the ownership, control, access, or maintenance of the private drives or mail delivery.
