The Center is intended for use by Hartsville/Trousdale County Residents only. Upon entering to the Center, any vehicles with out of town plates will be asked to present proof of residence.

If you will need help unloading your vehicle/trailer or placing trash into our containers, please bring help with you. The Hartsville/Trousdale Convenience Center is not equipped to unload personal vehicles.

Construction, Demolition, Commercial Waste at this facility must be taken to a certified landfill. It will be at the attendance discretion if it can be dispose of at this site.

- The Center will accept household waste and recyclable materials. Commercial, business, and demolition waste will not be accepted.
- Recyclable materials should be separated from trash before arrival to the center.
- The equivalent of one level pickup truck load per day will be accepted.
- All large appliances must be free of food or perishables before arrival at the Center.
- No dump trailers.
- No scavenging is allowed.
- No dumping when the Center is closed.
- No box trucks are allowed.
- See the other side of this sheet for recycling information.
- No Hazardous Waste.
- No paint See recycling schedule on back
- No trailer over 10ft. around the compactor only
- All firearms to remain inside vehicle

## What Can Be Recycled at the Hartsville/Trousdale Convenience Center?

- #1 and #2 Plastics like soda bottles and milk jugs
- Clean newspaper
- Clean cardboard
- Empty tin cans
- Empty glass
- Empty aluminum cans
- White goods like refrigerators and stoves
- Scrap metal
- Batteries
- Tires- (max. 4 non-commercial tires per auto owned/titled in household)  
A charge for each tire after the allowed 4 will be assessed
- All waste oil: See attendant for assistance.
- Furniture, televisions, computers: See attendant for disposal.
- Garbage: Household waste only. Commercial and demolition waste must be taken to the Smith County Landfill.
- Brush: Residential yard brush and trimmings only. See attendant for assistance.
- Household Hazardous Waste: Accepted on designated hazardous waste collection days only. Please watch newspaper for date and times.

Please keep in mind all recycling is for households only. No business or commercial materials should be brought to HTC Convenience Center for recycling.

Construction, Demolition, Commercial Waste: Must be taken to Smith County Landfill in Carthage, Tn. Not accepted at the Convenience Center.
