**November 19, 2020**

## **Minutes from September 8, 2020:**

Motion made by Walsh and seconded by Baker to approve minutes. All in favor.

## **Election of Officers:**

Motion by Jones for all to remain the same Dwight Jewell to be Chair, Gary Walsh to be Vice Chair and Beverly Atwood to be Secretary and 2<sup>nd</sup> by Burton. All in favor.

## **Old Business:**

Mayor – Report from Bob Bass Tennessee Corrections Snapshot of findings/recommendations attached.

I will be reaching out to CTAS to set up another meeting on the latest summary report. We are 1 over for 2020 in inmates that 5 from 2019.

Had a meeting today on reduction of COVID cases.

Walsh – Mayor when is the sunset date of the wheel tax? Mayor – May 25, 2022.

Sheriff – We are still working on getting video hearings set up with an open P.O. to get items needed. Working with the guy we always have.

MOU is out of date with the Board of education regarding the SOR's/ Dr. Satterfield has made a lot of changes to last years and I do not feel it is appropriate to sign. In ex: he is requesting the officers to transport student to ISS in a patrol car. There has been a meeting and the TCBOE attorney and County attorney are working out the details. I cannot elaborate any further.

Mayor stated this does not need to be gone into detail as the attorneys are handling. Although a private meeting could be set with the commissioners and the county attorney.

Jewell stated to the Sheriff he is need of assistance from the Committee they would do as they are allowed.

Burton stated the Justice Center needs new holding doors as they are commercial doors and not cell doors. The other day they had to take a crowbar to one to get the offenders out due to the door would not unlock or open. This is the way it was built as the light switches were also placed on the inside of the cell doors. Sheriff is looking into the cost and was taking the commissioners after the meeting to see exactly what they were referring to.

Motion made by Walsh to adjourn with all in favor.
