## **Public Works Director Report:**

Sallee and Gregory met with John Edwards and an Engineer from Border State regarding the ball field lighting. Information was intended to be ready for tonight's meeting but have not heard back from them. Also spoke with an Engineer from Tri-County regarding and he explained Musco is the way to go; Wilson and Macon county both have used them. They are using them for Little League and Softball fields. COVID has a lot of this on standstill.

As we are pressing toward winter, we have a tree down on the property near the radio station.

Gregory – Would like to welcome Commissioner Lonnie Taylor. He built pools in college. He will be a big asset to the Committee.

Chambers – Tri-County would like to add some fiber lines at the park for Wi-Fi; in which I agreed to make these additions. This would be like a Hotspot not anything for great length of streaming.

## **Grants**

1.) Local Park and Recreation Grant with ADA improvements initially for 2021 – was straightened out for the 2020 year. We have till December 7<sup>th</sup> to get items completed to place with this application: 2 public meetings, 2 Civic organizations (He will be addressing the Rotary November 19.) we will have one public meeting prior to the Commission meeting Monday, November 23, 2020. The next will be a virtual/Zoom meeting December 2<sup>nd</sup> at 12 noon. We will also have comment cards at the Administration building. These items have to be submitted with the Grant application.

2.) Building Environment Grant application phase not open yet awaiting to here back. The gentlemen that I spoke with before is no longer in that position., although he has sent me information that will be helpful. This is just a straight amount although it is extremely competitive.
