Mayor's Report:

Mayor has called a virtual meeting of the Commission to consider a resolution for a Tennessee Department of Economic and Community Development Grant on March 8, 2021. The deadline is March 12, 2021. There is a 10% local match that Tennessee Central, not the County, will pay. The County is essentially just a pass through between the State and Tennessee Central.

Have received a request from TC Medical Center for a resolution to be approved by the Commission.

Jewell stated that there is a resolution originating In Grainger County TN to ask the state to add Training at TCAT's, in meat processing, to their curriculum. There is a need statewide for skilled laborers in the meat processing industry. Since we now have a Meat processing industry that it would be good for us to show our support of the idea. He will submit a resolution on this month's agenda.

Mayor – There will be quite a few rezoning issues this month.
