

Ridgeline Expansion Project Opportunity

Position: Company Ambassador

Description

Enbridge Inc. is seeking established, community-engaged professionals to serve in a part-time capacity as company ambassadors to support our work on the Ridgeline Expansion Project (Ridgeline). An Enbridge ambassador would serve as a project liaison with community leaders and various stakeholders in counties along the project's projected route. The scope of Ridgeline spans eight Tennessee counties including Trousdale, Smith, Jackson, Putnam, Overton, Fentress, Morgan and Roane. Enbridge is proposing to design, construct and operate Ridgeline as an expansion to its existing East Tennessee Natural Gas (ETNG) system. This potential expansion would serve as one of the power generation options the Tennessee Valley Authority (TVA) is currently considering in connection with its proposed replacement of the Kingston Fossil Plant, as the coal units at the plant are proposed to retire in 2026 to 2033.

Qualifications

- Must be a resident of one of the eight counties along Ridgeline's projected route
- Possess a well-rounded knowledge of their community; have an ability to cultivate relationships with key stakeholders
- Strong in communications and networking skills
- Background as a local leader – possibly as a municipal or county official – or experience in business and/or technical fields is preferred
- Ability to travel for frequent meetings and various community engagement events

Responsibilities

- Work closely with Ridgeline stakeholders and the Enbridge communications team
- Thoroughly familiarize self and personally commit to Enbridge's mission, vision and goals
- Educate community members on Ridgeline and its benefits
- Further build on existing relationships and foster new ones
- Represent Enbridge at community gatherings, luncheons, meetings, etc.
