

ORDINANCE 2020-0420A

**AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING TEMPORARY WORK ZONE
SPEED LIMITS UNDER I.C. §9-21-5-11**

WHEREAS, Warren County currently has an area of its land under construction due to the installation of the Jordan Creek Wind Farm;

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners of Warren County (“Commissioners”) believe that it is in the best interest of all citizens of and travelers through Warren County, Indiana, to establish a temporary maximum speed limit;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Board of Commissioners of Warren County, Indiana:

1. This Ordinance is adopted pursuant to I.C. § 9-21-5-11 and the Commissioners are deemed the local authority able to establish the temporary work zone speed limits as described below.
2. The Commissioners have established the boundaries of the work area as the following:
 - a. Illinois state line to the west;
 - b. Benton county line to the north;
 - c. Highway 41/63 (4 lane) to the east; and
 - d. Highway 28 to the south.
3. Within this work area, a temporary maximum speed limit of 35 miles per hour is established on all County roads.
4. Any violation of this Ordinance is punishable, pursuant to I.C. § 9-21-5-11(d), by the following

a. If the person has not previously committed the infraction of violating a speed limit set under this ordinance, a judgment for a Class B infraction and a fine of at least three hundred dollars (\$300.00) shall be imposed;

b. If the person has committed one (1) infraction of violating a speed limit set under this ordinance in the previous three (3) years, a judgment for a Class B infraction and a fine of at least five hundred dollars (\$500.00) shall be imposed; and


c. If the person has committed two (2) or more infractions of violating a speed limit set under this ordinance in the previous three (3) years, a judgment for a Class B infraction and a fine of one thousand dollars (\$1,000.00) shall be imposed.

5. This Ordinance is effective as of April 20, 2020, after the posting of signs along the affected roads, and continues in effect for one (1) year or until its repeal, whichever occurs first.




