

ORDINANCE 92-1

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE WARREN COUNTY COUNCIL MEETING DURING THEIR BUDGET HEARINGS ADOPTED THE FOLLOWING SALARIES OF THE VARIOUS OFFICES TO BE APPROPRIATED FOR THE BUDGET YEAR OF 1992 PURSUANT TO THE PROVISIONS OF THE PUBLIC LAW 249:

SALARIES: COUNCILMAN DAVID DALTON MOTIONED TO BRING JAILORS SALARIES UP TO COURTHOUSE DEPUTY SALARIES AND TO ALLOW ALL DEPUTIES, APPOINTED POSITIONS, AND ALL OFFICE HOLDERS A \$750.00 RAISE. MOTION PASSED

EXTRA HELP:* COUNCIL ALLOWED EXTRA HELP AT \$5.00 PER HOUR RATHER THAN A DAILY RATE AS IN YEARS PRIOR.

3/5'S AND 4/5'S DEPUTY POSITIONS COUNCIL VOTES TO RETAIN BOTH THESE POSITIONS IN THE SURVEYOR AND AREA PLAN AND THE 4/5 POSITION IN CLERK'S **COUNCIL SUGGESTED TO AREA PLAN TO POST HOURS ON DOOR AS WELL AS IN NEWSPAPER:
