

ORDINANCE 94-1

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE WARREN COUNTY COUNCIL MEETING IS SPECIAL SESSION SEPTEMBER 7, 1993 DID ADOPT THE SALARUES AND BUDGETS FOR THE YEAR 1994 PURSUANT TO PREVISIONS OF THE PUBLIC LAW 249:

SEE FINAL 1994 BUDGET IN COMPUTERIZED FORM IN SPECIAL FOLDER

SALARIES: COUNCIL MOTIONED AND PASSED BY ALL COUNCILMEN TO ALLOW A \$1,000 RAISE---COUNTY CLERK AND CO-SUPER-INTENDENT AT COUNTY HOME ALLOWED A \$1,500 RAISE. AT COUNCIL SEPTEMBER 27, 1993, MEETING COUNCIL VOTED TO INCREASE CLERK'S SALARY TO MEET AUDITOR'S 94 SALARY.

HOURLY PERSONNEL: COUNCIL VOTED A 48¢ AN HOUR RAISE.

EXTRA HELP: COUNCIL VOTED TO LEAVE EXTRA HELP AT \$5.00 PER HOUR.

3/5's AND 4/5's DEPUTY POSITION: COUNCIL VOTED TO REINSTATE THESE POSITIONS TO FULLTIME WITH THE UNDERSTANDING THE OFFICES OF SURVEYOR AND AREA PLAN ARE TO BE STAFFED AND OPEN TO THE PUBLIC 8-4 AS OTHER OFFICES.
