

RESOLUTION NO. 2024-0805B

**RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING GREATER LAFAYETTE PUBLIC
TRANSPORTATION CORPORATION TO EXPAND A VANPOOL PROGRAM
OUTSIDE THE BOUNDARIES OF TIPPECANOE COUNTY TO WARREN COUNTY**

WHEREAS, I.C. 36-9-1-9 defines the operational boundaries of for the operation of the public transit system of Greater Lafayette Public Transportation Corporation (“GLPTC”);

WHEREAS, on May 1, 2023, pursuant to Resolution 2023-14, the Common Council of the City of Lafayette, Indiana, approved an expansion of the service area of GLPTC to include all of Tippecanoe County;

WHEREAS, pursuant to I.C. 36-9-4-29.4, GLPTC desires to expand its service area to include portions of Warren County for the purpose of expanding its work force commute program utilizing vanpools which will enhance employment opportunities and quality of life through improved access to services within the expanded service area by addressing transportation barriers and will assist in the development of the local workforce;

WHEREAS, the vanpool program will be completely funded without the use of any funds from the City of Lafayette or an increase in the tax rate;

WHEREAS, in order for GLPTC to proceed with proving expanded service in Warren County, the Common Council must first approve expansion of the GLPTC service area as described in this Resolution.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LAFAYETTE, INDIANA:

Section 1. The Council finds that the expansion of the GLPTC service area will enhance, and is reasonably necessary to enhance, employment opportunities access to community services, within the expanded service area and the existing service area by addressing transportation barriers and will assist with the development of the local work force;

Section 2. The service area for GLPTC’s vanpool program, and for any other purpose contemplated by I.C. 36-9-4-29.4, is hereby expanded to include all of WARREN COUNTY.

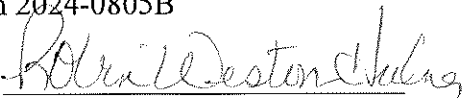
Section 3. This Resolution if passed in conformity with I.C. 36-9-4-29.4;

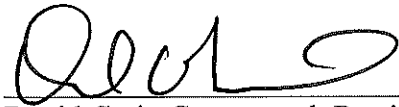
Section 4. This Resolution shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and any and all necessary approval by the Board of Commissioners.

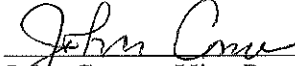

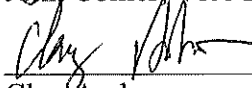
