

**ORDINANCE NO. 2025-0616A**  
**AN ORDINANCE REGULATING POSTING SIGNS ON UTILITY POLES**

WHEREAS, the County Commissioners have noticed a large increase in the number of advertisements and posters posted on utility poles throughout the County; and

WHEREAS, local utilities have attempted to regulate the posting on utility poles themselves without County involvement; and

WHEREAS, the County Commissioners believe it is in the best interest of the health, safety and welfare of the citizens of Warren County, Indiana to regulate the posting of signs on utility poles throughout the County.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Warren County Commissioners that the Warren County Code is amended as follows:

Section \_\_\_\_\_ POSTING ON UTILITY POLES

No person, other than the utility who owns the pole, shall post or affix any notice, poster, or other paper or advertisement which is calculated to attract the attention of the public, to any public utility pole, or shade tree, except as may be authorized by law.


Any person violating any provision of this Section shall be assessed a fine of Fifty Dollars (\$50.00) per occurrence and such notice, poster, or other advertisement shall be removed and disposed of accordingly.


Nothing in this Ordinance is intended to supersede the authority or rights of the pole owner, nor impact any remedies the Owner may pursue against any person who posts materials on a utility pole.


This Ordinance shall be effect as of its passage and subsequent publication.


