

ORDINANCE NO. 2026-0217C

ORDINANCE REGARDING VACATION OF ALLEY IN WARREN COUNTY

Comes now the Warren County Board of Commissioners, and makes the following recitals and ordains as follows:

WHEREAS, Warren County currently has an alley which the Petitioner, David Collins, is petitioning to vacate, described as follows:

*An alley twenty-two (22) feet in width and two hundred forty (240) feet in length running North to South along the East line of Lots 96, 97, 98 and 99 in the Town of Judyville, Warren County, Indiana and the West line of Lots 116, 115, 114 and 113 in the Town of Judyville, Warren County, Indiana.*

WHEREAS, David Collins is the owner of real estate adjacent to said alley and has filed a Petition for the vacation of the alley; and

WHEREAS, notice of said petition was given, and a hearing was held, pursuant to Indiana Code §36-7-3-12, and at that hearing no person aggrieved by the proposed vacation objected to said petition;

IT IS THEREFORE ORDAINED AS FOLLOWS:

1. That said alley situated in Warren County, Indiana, described as follows:

*An alley twenty-two (22) feet in width and two hundred forty (240) feet in length running North to South along the East line of Lots 96, 97, 98 and 99 in the Town of Judyville, Warren County, Indiana and the West line of Lots 116, 115, 114 and 113 in the Town of Judyville, Warren County, Indiana.*

is vacated, subject to the reservation of easements as subsequently described.

2. That Warren County reserves to itself an easement extending the length and breadth of said alleys for the construction, maintenance, and operation or reconstruction of utilities in, through, over or under the same.



3. That the vacation of said alley is subject to the rights of all public utilities in said road, and the Petitioner requesting such vacation shall be responsible to the public utilities for any vacating, re-arrangement or relocating costs in the event the same are necessary without any costs to Warren County, its successors or assigns.

4. That all costs incident to the above mentioned vacation are to be paid by Petitioner.


5. That all ordinances or parts of ordinances conflicting with the provisions of this ordinance are repealed.
