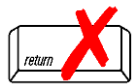

This letter is to certify that our office has inspected the above reference property with respect to the approved Order of Conditions issued December 7, 1984. The work to construct a wooden bulkhead appears to have been completed as designed, however, a new shoreline protection revetment was installed to replace the structure. The approved revetment (Order of Conditions issued 1-30-2002 as DEP File # 79-171, for which a Certificate of Compliance was issued 8-17-2004) left approximately 20' of the original structure intact and that portion of the bulkhead is still visible on the property.
