RESOLUTION NO. 2025-021

WHEREAS, the California Department of Aging (CDA) is designated as the State Unit on Aging under the Older Americans Act (OAA). In this role, CDA contracts with 33 Area Agencies on Aging (AAAs) throughout the state to provide a variety of services authorized under both the OAA and the Older Californians Act (OCA); and

WHEREAS, the CDA determines the geographic boundaries designated as a Planning Service Area (PSA) to deliver AAA program services and requires an application for consideration of geographical designation; and

WHEREAS, an AAA is defined as an identifiable private nonprofit or public agency designated by CDA which engages in community planning, coordination and program development, and, through contractual arrangements, provides a broad array of social and nutritional services which are supported by a combination of federal, state, and local funds; and

WHEREAS, all AAAs provide supportive services to adults aged 60 and over and adults with disabilities related to nutrition, health and wellness, caregiver support, elder justice, transportation and legal assistance; and

WHEREAS, in 1983, Yuba County entered into a Joint Powers Agreement (JPA) between the counties of Nevada, Placer, Sacramento, Sierra, Sutter, and Yolo for the purpose of implementing the OAA; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to the JPA, a public entity known as "Agency on Aging Area 4" (AAA4) was created, and is a public entity separate and apart from the counties of Nevada, Placer, Sacramento, Sierra, Sutter, Yolo, and Yuba; and

WHEREAS, the AAA4, through its governing board makes applications to, accepts grant funds from, and enters into contracts with the state and federal government for funds to be used for the purposes consistent with the OAA and OCA; and

WHEREAS, the Yuba County Health and Human Services Department (YCHHSD) has an interest to explore the option of Yuba County applying for its own Planning Service Area and Local Area Agency on Aging designation with the California Department of Aging to access funding and provide services consistent with needs of Yuba County.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the County of Yuba supports YCHHSD in the effort to explore the feasibility of directly accessing the Yuba County OAA and OCA funding currently allocated to AAA4, pursuant to the JPA, and to administer programs for Yuba County residents aged 60 and over and adults with disabilities.


