WHEREAS, on July 8, 2025, the Board of Supervisors adopted Resolution number 2025-049 formally adopting the Classification System – Basic Salary/Hourly Schedule in its entirety, effective July 1, 2025; and

WHEREAS, the County and DSA met and conferred in good faith regarding wages, hours, and working conditions and mutually agreed to the terms for a successor MOU for the period of August 1, 2025 and ending on June 30, 2027; and

WHEREAS, the adoption of a range table for DSA implementing a 0.5% between classifications will align the DSA’s structure with the rest of the County’s bargaining units; and

WHEREAS, the proposed ranges for DSA classifications are as follows:

WHEREAS, the Board of Supervisors now intends to amend Resolution No. 2025-049 as it relates to the Classification System – Basic Salary/Hourly Schedule as it relates to all DSA classifications, effective August 1, 2025; and

WHEREAS, on March 22, 2017, the Board of Supervisors approved the Reserve Deputy IA hourly rate is equivalent to the Deputy Sheriff hourly rate, the Reserve Deputy I is twenty-five percent (25%) less than the Reserve Deputy IA, and the Reserve Deputy II is twenty-five percent (25%) less than the Deputy Reserve I; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Supervisors now intends to amend Resolution No. 2025-049 as it relates to the Extra Help Hourly Schedule as it relates to Reserve Deputy Level 1A-1-2 classifications, effective August 1, 2025.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Board of Supervisors of the County of Yuba, that Resolution number 2025-049 be and hereby is amended as it relates to the contractual agreement with DSA represented and extra help classifications.

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BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, the Classification System Comprised of the Basic Salary/Hourly Schedule as documented in Attachment "A"; and Extra-Help Classification System Hourly Schedule as documented in Attachment "B" attached hereto and incorporated herein reference as though fully set forth, is hereby established and effective August 1, 2025.


