EXECUTION OF AGREEMENT FOR YUBA)
COUNTY JAIL MEDICAL AND) RESOLUTION NO. 2025-080
BEHAVIORAL HEALTH SERVICES.)
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WHEREAS, Yuba County Sheriff’s Department operates the Yuba County Jail Facility (“Facility”), an adult correctional facility located in Marysville, California; and

WHEREAS, the Facility is required by California’s Title 15 regulations, *Minimum Standards for Local Detention Facilities*, to provide access to medical and behavioral healthcare services for incarcerated individuals in custody; and

WHEREAS, Yuba County Administrative Services issued Request for Proposal 901994 in May 2025 to solicit qualified vendors licensed in California to provide on-site and on-call medical and behavioral healthcare services, consistent with standards established by the National Commission on Correctional Health Care (NCCHC), Title 15, Title 24, the *Hedrick* Second Amended Consent Decree, and all other applicable state and federal laws; and

WHEREAS, Yuba County Administrative Services issued a Notice of Intent to Award the contract to Correctional Healthcare Partners (“CHP”), Inc. on June 13, 2025;

WHEREAS, the former medical and behavioral healthcare services provider notified the County it would discontinue services at the Facility effective September 30, 2025, creating the need for an emergency agreement executed by the Purchasing Agent to ensure continuity of care; and

WHEREAS, the Agreement (No. 2025-123), negotiated with CHP, Inc., will ensure that individuals incarcerated in the Facility have access to appropriate medical and behavioral healthcare services, including pharmacy services and services required under the California Advancing and Innovating Medi-Cal/CalAIM Justice-Involved Initiative; and

WHEREAS, on September 29, 2025, the Purchasing Agent executed the Agreement, No. 2025-123, with Correctional Healthcare Partners, Inc., in accordance with Section 10.3 of the County Purchasing and Contract Policy Manual; and

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WHEREAS, subsequent to the execution of the Agreement, Correctional Healthcare Partners, Inc., executed the First Amendment to Agreement No. 2025-123 (“First Amendment”), assigning and transferring all of their rights, duties and obligations under the Agreement to CHPYUBA, Inc.; and CHPYUBA, Inc., executed the First Amendment, assuming all of the rights, duties and obligations under the Agreement with the County of Yuba to provide medical and behavioral healthcare services for incarcerated persons at the Facility.

WHEREAS, the Purchasing Agent consented to Correctional Healthcare Partners, Inc.’s assignment of its rights, duties and obligations under the Agreement to CHPYUBA, Inc., and consented to CHPYUBA, Inc.’s assumption of all rights, duties and obligations under the Agreement, subject to providing proof of insurance; and

WHEREAS, CHPYUBA, Inc. provided the County of Yuba proof of insurance as required;

WHEREAS, the Agreement is effective October 1, 2025, through September 30, 2032, with the County agreeing to pay CHPYUBA, Inc. the amounts set forth in Exhibit E of the Agreement herein attached; for the first year, the amount shall not exceed Six Million, One Hundred Twenty-Eight Thousand Seven Hundred Sixty-Eight Dollars and Forty Cents (\$6,128,768.40), and that amount was budgeted for within the Fiscal Year 2025-26 Board of Supervisors approved budget appropriation; and

WHEREAS, the annual payments to CHPYUBA, Inc. shall increase for each subsequent contract year pursuant to the terms set forth in Exhibit E of the Agreement.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, the Yuba County Board of Supervisors hereby:

1. Ratifies and approves the Agreement, No. 2025-123, between Yuba County and Correctional Healthcare Partners, Inc., for the provision of on-site and on-call medical and behavioral healthcare services at the Yuba County Jail, as executed by the County Purchasing Agent on September 29, 2025, pursuant to Section 10.3 of the County Purchasing and Contract Policy Manual;
2. Ratifies and approves the First Amendment to Agreement No. 2025-123 wherein the Purchasing Agent consented to CHP, Inc.’s assignment and transfer of the Agreement to CHPYUBA, Inc., and CHPYUBA, Inc.’s assumption of the Agreement, assuming all rights, responsibilities and duties under the Agreement;
3. The Board acknowledges and approves the Agreement term of October 1, 2025 through September 30, 2032, and the payment amounts to CHPYUBA, Inc. in accordance with Exhibit E of the Agreement; the first year shall not exceed Six Million, One Hundred Twenty-Eight Thousand Seven Hundred Sixty-Eight Dollars and Forty Cents (\$6,128,768.40);
4. Directs the Sheriff’s Department, in coordination with the Administrative Services Department, to oversee and monitor the contractor’s performance to ensure compliance with the National Commission on Correctional Health Care (NCCHC) standards, Title 15

and Title 24 regulations, the *Hedrick* Second Amended Consent Decree, and all other applicable state and federal laws;

5. Authorizes the Auditor-Controller to allocate and disburse the necessary funds for the Agreement as approved in the County budget in accordance with manner and payment schedule set forth in the Agreement.


