RESOLUTION NO. 2025-083

WHEREAS, in FY 2023/2024, the Yuba County Board of Supervisors approved creation of the Yes to Startups Program in partnership with California Capital Financial Development Corporation (California Capital FDC), host to the Sacramento Valley Small Business Development Center (SBDC), to provide structured training, mentorship, and seed funding for local entrepreneurs; and

WHEREAS, the Yes to Startups Program has since graduated over 35 entrepreneurs across two cohorts, launched four new businesses, created or retained 21 jobs, and helped participants secure more than \$170,000 in loans, equity, or grants, delivering measurable community-wide economic impacts; and

WHEREAS, the program provides a seven-week online curriculum, ongoing mentorship, and a two-round pitch competition awarding up to \$40,000 in direct grants to participants; and

WHEREAS, FY 2025/2026 will mark the third annual Yes to Startups Program cohort, continuing to expand entrepreneurial opportunities for Yuba County residents; and

WHEREAS, under the FY 2025/2026 Memorandum of Understanding, Yuba County will provide California Capital FDC \$20,000 for coaching, training, and administration, and \$22,000 (including \$18,000 roll-over from FY 2024/2025) for business grants, for a total program cost not to exceed \$42,000; and

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, by the Board of Supervisors of the County of Yuba:

1. The Board of Supervisors hereby approves the continuation of the Yes to Startups Program in FY 2025/2026, in partnership with California Capital FDC and the Sacramento Valley SBDC.
2. The Board Chair is authorized to sign the FY 2025/2026 Memorandum of Understanding with California Capital FDC in the amount of \$42,000, which includes \$20,000 for program administration and \$22,000 for participant micro-grants.


