**WHEREAS**, Yuba County Probation Department, desires to participate in the 2025 Edward Byrne Memorial Justice Assistance Grant (JAG) Equipment and Training Program administered by the Board of State and Community Corrections (hereafter referred to as the BSCC); and

**WHEREAS**, the BSCC is the designated State Administering Agency for the JAG Program, which is federally funded through the Bureau of Justice Assistance (BJA). The JAG Program is the primary provider of federal criminal justice funding to state and local jurisdictions; and

**WHEREAS**, the BSCC administers the JAG Program as a competitive grant program every two to three years; and

**WHEREAS**, the JAG Equipment and Training Program is a separate and distinct, one-time allocation funding opportunity; and

**WHEREAS**, the JAG Equipment and Training Program RFA offers funding to all California counties through a non-competitive, population-based formula; and

**WHEREAS**, Yuba County has applied for and been approved for grant funding in the amount of \$57,239.00; and

**WHEREAS**, this Resolution desires to have the Board of Supervisors ratify Yuba County applying for the grant, and to authorize and delegate authority to the Chief Probation Officer to execute the grant agreement and all other documents, receive and disperse funds in



**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED**, the Yuba County Board of Supervisors hereby ratifies the submission of the grant application for the BSCC 2025 Edward Byrne Memorial Justice Assistance Grant (JAG) Equipment and Training Program.

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** the Yuba County Board of Supervisors authorizes and delegates authority to the Chief Probation Officer to execute the Grant Agreement and all necessary related documents, accept and administer grant funding from BSCC 2025 Edward Byrne Memorial Justice Assistance Grant (JAG) Equipment and Training Program.




