RESOLUTION NO. 2026-28

WHEREAS, the California Department of Public Health (CDPH), Sexually Transmitted Diseases Control Branch (STD CB), has made funding available through the Disease Intervention Specialist (DIS) Workforce Development Grant; and

WHEREAS, the DIS Workforce Development Grant supports local health jurisdictions in building and sustaining workforce capacity for disease investigation, contact tracing, outbreak response, and communicable-disease control activities. Its purpose is to strengthen public health staffing and operational capacity; and

WHEREAS, CDPH STDCB has allocated Yuba County \$54,803 for FY 2025-2026 and \$109,606 each year from FY 2026-2027 to FY 2029-2030 for a total allocation of \$493,227. Counties must sign and submit the grant agreement and all required documents to accept these funds; and

WHEREAS, the HHSD Director seeks authorization to submit the grant agreement and all required documents necessary for Yuba County to receive DIS Workforce Development funding.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Yuba County Board of Supervisors that the HHSD Director is hereby authorized to submit the grant agreement and all required documents for Yuba County’s DIS Workforce Development funds, including any subsequent allocations.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Yuba County Board of Supervisors that the HHSD Director is hereby authorized, subject to review and approval by County Counsel, to execute all documents required by the DIS Workforce Development Grant and the

resultant funding allocations for the term of July 1, 2025 through June 30, 2030, including any subsequent grant extensions; to execute future amendments to support the continuation of DIS Workforce Development activities, including but not limited to amendments providing additional or lesser funding; and to accept, transfer, and administer all DIS Workforce Development funds, including any subsequent funding allocations received during the grant term or any extended term.

A copy of the executed agreement or any amendment thereto shall be filed in the office of the Clerk of the Board.
