**WHEREAS**, the California Department of Housing and Community Development (the “Department” or “HCD”) issued a Notice of Funding Availability (“NOFA”) for the Community Development Block Grant Program (“CDBG”)- Mitigation Planning and Public Services (“MITPPS”), made available from the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (“HUD”), pursuant to the CDBG Program-Audible Alarm System Project; and

**WHEREAS**, the Community Development and Services Agency, on behalf of the County of Yuba, applied for and received an allocation of funding in the amount of \$500,000 from the State of California Department of Housing and Community Development (HCD), Standard Agreement No. 17-MITPPS-21033 to be utilized to; and

**WHEREAS**, the County submitted an amendment to HCD following Agenda Item 584/2025 for the Audible Alarm System Project to transform it from a Public Services-Audible Fire Alarm/Siren Network project into a Planning project, to amend the scope of work with a breakdown of approved grant activities to be completed by the County monthly, the performance deadline extending the grant activities out by six months extending the expiration date of the Standard Agreement(s) by six months, and reducing the budget for the County to use \$250,000 in funds rather than the previously awarded \$500,000; and

**WHEREAS**, it is the recommendation of the Community Development and Services Agency that the Yuba County Board of Supervisors adopt a resolution authorizing the closeout

of the CDBG Program, and the execution and submittal of a grant closeout certification, and request to disencumber unused funds, as required by the California State Department of Housing and Community Development; and

**WHEREAS**, funding has been expended for the completion of the Audible Alarm planning project, which offers a plan for the future construction of audible alarm sirens, enhanced expertise for wildfire response related mitigation efforts, community education, preparedness, response, and recovery of the Yuba County community, should a future disaster arise in the Sierra Foothills; and

**WHEREAS**, all activities undertaken with CDBG funds provided under the above grant agreement have been carried out in accordance with the grant agreement, and proper provision has been made for the payment of all costs and claims, and that amounts set forth are true and correct; and

**WHEREAS**, the Community Development and Services Agency recommends and requests the Board of Supervisors to authorize and direct the Director of Community Development and Services Agency, or its designee, to execute and deliver all documents pertaining to grant closeout, and act on the County's behalf in all matters pertaining to grant closeout, and direct staff to complete and submit the Final Financial and Accomplishment Report in the grant management system (eCivis); and

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED**, the Yuba County Board of Supervisors hereby declares:

*Section 1.* That the above recitals are all true and correct.

*Section 2.* That the Yuba County Board of Supervisors hereby adopts a resolution authorizing the Community Development and Services Agency staff to closeout Standard Agreement No. 17-MITPPS-21033 and submit a closeout certification, and request to disencumber unused funds, as required by the California State Department of Housing and Community Development; and

*Section 3.* That the Yuba County Board of Supervisors have reviewed the revenue and expenditures, and National Objective, and accepts the Yuba County CDBG Program; and

*Section 4.* That the Yuba County Board of Supervisors have reviewed the Financial Revenue and Expenditures and accepts that all activities undertaken with CDBG funds provided under the above grant agreement have been carried out, and that proper provisions have been made for the payment of all costs and claims; and

*Section 5.* The County Board of Supervisors hereby authorizes and directs the Director of Community Development and Services Agency, or its designee, to execute and deliver all closeout documents, and act on the County's behalf in all matters pertaining to the closeout of the above stated grant, and directs staff to complete and submit the Final Financial and Accomplishment Report in the grant management system (eCivis); and

*Section 6.* This Resolution shall take effect upon its adoption.


