

## ASSESSMENT APPEALS BOARD NO. 2

<b>PURPOSE:</b>	Sits as the County's Local Board of Equalization to allow taxpayers the opportunity to challenge the assessment of their property placed on the roll by the County Assessor.
<b>FUNCTIONS:</b>	A 3-member panel hears and decides property assessment disputes filed by residential and business taxpayers. Based upon proper evidence received, equalizes the assessed properties, and makes determinations of law.
<b>QUALIFICATIONS:</b>	Must be licensed or certified by the State of California as a CPA/Public Accountant, Attorney, Real Estate Broker, property appraiser accredited by a nationally recognized professional organization for a period of 5 years and maintain qualifications throughout the term of office, or a person which the Board of Supervisors believes possesses competent knowledge of property appraisal and taxation.
<b>TERM OF OFFICE:</b>	Three-year term
<b>APPOINTEES:</b>	Three
<b>MEETINGS:</b>	The Assessment Appeals Board meets Monday at 9:00 a.m. one to two times during the months of January through May and periodically the remainder of the year dependent upon the number of applications filed with meetings last from 1 – 4 hours. All hearings are conducted in the Board Chambers at the Yuba County Government Center.
<b>COMPENSATION:</b>	Members receive \$75 per hour with a \$150 minimum per meeting
